School wide Running program

Spring is around the corner and the weather will be improving soon. Track and Field season (for all grade 3 to 7 students) is here soon. As a result, we'll be stepping up our run frequency and overall effort. We currently run as a whole school on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

As a reminder, we have the following running goals for students for our students: Students K to 3 are able to run 1 lap without having to stop to walk, and students in grades 4 to 7 are able to run 2 laps without having to stop to walk. These goals are much easier to achieve if children have suitable running shoes. As an added incentive, we will be monitoring each class and their progress, and offering some fun prizes for effort.
