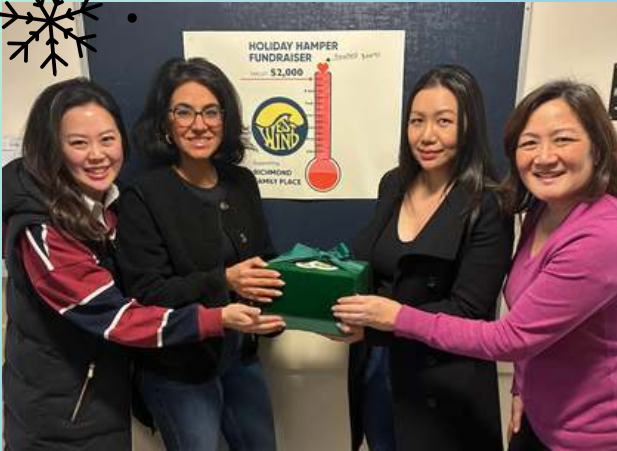

VOLUNTEER INTERPRETERS NEEDED

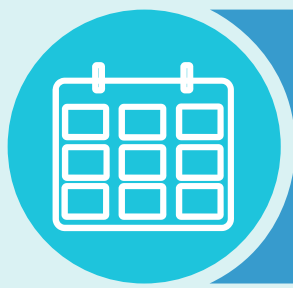


The Richmond School District is seeking individuals who are fluent in English and other languages to join our Volunteer Interpreter Team.
