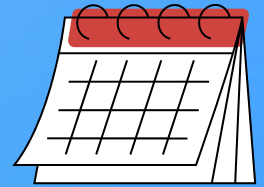
STRATEGIC PLAN 2026-2030

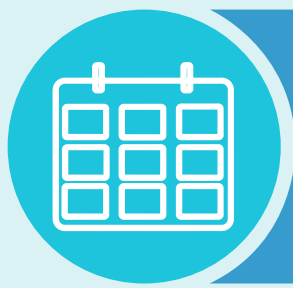
