Reports

3.1 Treasurer's Report - see attached submitted by Hanif Hamir. Moved by Kelly Booth that the Month End report be approved as circulated. CARRIED (Lara and Chris)

3.2 Principal's Report

- Thank you for the supply cart. They have been filled and are ready for the teacher's to use.
- With leftover money from the Scholastic sales the K's received a new carpet and earphones were purchased for the learning centre.
- Wondering if a BGLTQ get real 1 hour work shop interactive Feb 5-9th is this something that parents would be interested in for children.
- There seems to be a consensus that a new photography company should be used for next year and that it should be in mid October. Mrs. Latu will check with other Admin to find another recommendation
- FSA's completed and it has been noted that as a school there can be more work
 done on writing. This focus will be taken back to the staff to discuss.
- December 15th will be the Winter Concert. There will be lessons all week and the
 performance will be that evening. Mrs. Latu is looking into whether it is possible to
 have a mini dress rehearsal in the afternoon so that other parents/kids can
 participate if they are unable to attend the evening performance.
- Holiday raffle will be happening again. Hannah is going to be taking it on. They will be using tickets this year instead of pieces of paper.

3.3 Fundraising Committee

- Winter Wonderland Bundle was extended to November 22,2017. Delivery of the Poinsettias/Wreaths & Pasta will be December 7, 2017.
- Winter Wonderland Breakfast 60 tickets have been sold so far, the grade 1 and 2's are making centre pieces. Volunteers are still needed for the day of to help. They have reached out to McMath for some student help.
- Lend a Hand December 2nd they will be packing the backpacks with all the donated items.
- Garden Club pumpkin smash was a big success. They are going to be working on a
 courtyard cleanup. They are still looking for more information on a fence and
 water source for the garden. Ms. Latu will put the request into the school board
 again as it seems to have been overlooked.

3.4 RDPA Committee

- The Richmond School District does not have any policy or plans to supply elementary schools with defibrillators but they do have them in the high schools.
- Traffic & Safety coordinator is meeting with the City and District so if Westwind
 has any specific requests we need to get that in ASAP (example: signs indicating
 school zone speed limit be moved further down the street and thus increasing
 school zone area).
- RDPA is supporting a collaboration between ICBC and Richmond School District in their efforts to bring back "Traffic Safety Week" (usually in March but more specific information will be given in the New Year)

New Business

4.1 Electronic Sign at front of school

- Kelly Booth is proposing that the PAC purchase an LED sign very simple and plain, encased in a frame with school logo - changed wirelessly. Purchased for the purpose of announcements, emergencies etc.
- Mrs. Latu and Kelly met with head electrician for the school board to find out costs. To buy the sign separately is between \$2,000-\$3,000 US. We are looking at one in the \$2,000 range. The estimate is to be around \$8,000 CDN. The cost would be for the sign and the materials. Labour to install the sign and build it would be free from the school board. The sign would be built during the year and installed in the summer and revealed at the start of next year.
- Kelly would like to earmark \$8,000 to put toward the sign.
- THOUGHTS/COMMENTS REGARDING THE SIGN
 - 1 parent would prefer to put the money toward the kids rather than toward a sign.
 - "Is there a need for this? Aren't we reaching enough people through Facebook, emails etc."
 - "How is this a benefit?" "Wouldn't it create more congestion at the drop off area?"
 - "Is there a concern about vandalism?"

 It has been decided to table this discussion until the next meeting and start a discussion in the Facebook group regarding whether this is a need for more communication.

4.2 Purchase of iPads for Teacher's use within the classroom

- Admin had previously requested money to purchase 20 iPads for use within the classrooms to facilitate the ministry's redesigned curriculum. These will be used within the classroom by the teachers to record student work and then can be reported back to the parents. There is a hope for more interaction with students and parents.
- The iPads would come directly from Apple and go to the tech department at the School Board to be set up and then to the school.
- Question brought forth "when we (PAC) buy things for the school/classroom, what happens when/if the teacher leaves? Do the items stay in the classroom?
 - Mrs. Latu confirms that yes, the items stay at the school and this has been discussed during staff meetings.
- Treasurer (Hanif) feels comfortable approving half the budget.
 - Hanif asks for a motion to approve \$5,000 for the Administrative iPad request.
 Melissa Woolford seconds the motion. All in Favour with No Objections. Motion is carried/approved.

5 Other Business

- Digital Citizenship refresher is probably a good idea. Maybe this can be mentioned to Deepani.
- Laura Grant is gathering more information about possibly bringing I Girl/I Guy to Westwind.
- Most Likely to Succeed Mrs. Latu/Mrs. Widdess is looking into possibly buying the rights to do a screening at the school.
