# Administrative Report

#### \*Received the wish list from teachers

- Admin have in their budget to get an iPad for each classroom teacher in order to document children's learning in action
- loose parts important for new curriculum carts that have baskets variety of items in each (shells, corks, glass beads etc) - use them in different learning
  - cart \$150 and then to fill it \$200 2-3 carts for the school
  - Hanif granted them \$500 to buy the carts and supplies to be shared throughout the school.
    - re-visit this in November to see if more money is needed

#### Book Fair funds \$1300

Admin asked whether some of the book fair money could be used to buy different items for the library - not just books - lego etc.

Admin is planning on booking an author visit - asking whether book fair money could be used toward that.

Question for Admin from parent: Safety around the school with the weather changing. Is there a plan in place for sidewalks and parking lot etc?-

### RDPA - Reported by Suzy White

 -Natural Disaster Preparedness - every class has an earthquake kit - Kelly checked last year and replaced all old ones.

Each bag includes a list that the district gave - mainly first aid supplies, flashlights etc. - no food items.

Health and safety meeting will be in charge of going through the bags (copy of the verification form needs to be updated)- not the teachers job -

- -can parents help with this? Kelly and Karla can do it again.
- Nicole Widdess is checking if parents are allowed to help with this.
- Mrs. Latu suggested that they could use noon hour supervisors to help with this

Westwind food safe - still needing volunteers to get certified. There should be at least 1 person with this certification at every food day.



Question: Health and Safety - defibrillator - we don't have one in the school - Suzy will look into this.

## Bench for Mrs. Lyle - dedication - cost \$2150.71

Question was brought forth: has anyone asked her if she wants this dedication? Nicole Widdess brought up that the District has a policy around dedicating things - lots of red tape around it as PAC's mandate is to support students.

We are shelving this at the moment in order to look more into these issues.

Sign at the front of the school - more information and the specific regulations around implementing this is needed.
