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### Significant Dates in our Community Black History Month: During Black History Month, people in February 2023

**Black History Month**: During Black History Month, people in Canada celebrate the many achievements and contributions of Black Canadians and their communities who, throughout history, have done so much to make Canada a culturally diverse, compassionate, and prosperous country.



**February 2: Vasant Panchami** is a day that is believed to be the birth of the Goddess Saraswati, and is dedicated to this Hindu Goddess of knowledge, music, arts, wisdom and learning.

February 5: Ash Wednesday - In Western Christianity, the first day of Lent, occurring six and a half weeks before Easter.

February 12:
