Presentation of updated 2025/2026 budget

Changes from last budget proposal:

- Special events increased to \$3,500 for K-pop lessons MOTION to approve Jordan, seconded Emily. PASSED
- Tech Budget- increased to \$7,500 from \$5,000 (50% of total cost). MOTION To approved Jordan, seconded Gigi .PASSED
 - School request to fund the entire cost (\$15K) similar to what we did in 2022 (money drive).
 - The goal is to have 3 kids to 1 device ratio. The district is stretched on resources.
- Other funding requests to consider before voting:
