### Treasurer's Report

Presentation of <u>August financial report</u>. We made more revenue last year than we budgeted for/spent, so we have a surplus! Classroom allocation was not spent. Make it easier for teachers to claim. Mrs. Tse & Ms Reid to encourage teachers to use the budget. Any remaining balance to be given to Ms. Nunn for literacy support.

- Presentation of updated <u>2025/2026 budget</u>
  - BC Gaming grant received today (\$9K). Overall expecting a deficit of \$9,975, covered by surplus funds from prior years. Need to start setting funds for spider net replacement.
    - Motion to approve in increase Class Contingency & Literacy Support: Jordan, seconded Cecilia, PASSED
    - Motion to approve increase in Field Trip, Jordan. Seconded Somaiah.PASSED
    - Motion to move mud kitchen budget to this year: Jordan, seconded Natalie. PASSED
    - Motion to reinstate PAC Discretionary Fund. Jordan, seconded Stephanie Clain PASSED.

  - Focus on Numeracy: Building an understanding between Mathematics and Numeracy. Numeracy is knowing how to apply mathematical skills in day to day activities (baking, shopping, gardening, etc).
