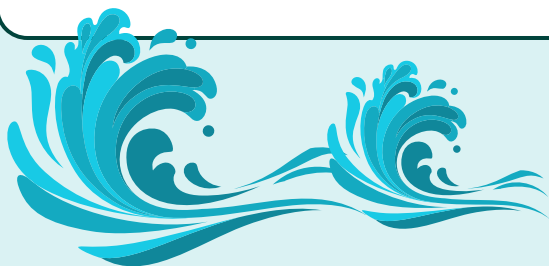

The Notice of Intent to Attend form was due at school **today!** Please have your children bring the form to school as soon as possible if you haven't done so already.

## Updated Volunteer Driver Form & Safety Protocols

To align with our district policy and to ensure the highest standard of safety for our students, all schools in the district are implementing updated protocols for volunteer drivers, effective immediately. Moving forward, all volunteer drivers are required to complete a Criminal Record Check (CRC) before transporting students. This is a mandatory step for any situation where volunteers may be alone with students or where direct staff supervision is minimal.

If you wish to volunteer as a driver for an upcoming field trip, please submit the following items to the school office (copies can be made at the office):

- A completed Volunteer Driver Authorization Form (new version - available on school website)
- Confirmation of CRC Submission (see instructions below)
- A copy of your current Driver's License
- A copy of your Vehicle Insurance

The great news is that there is no cost for school volunteers to obtain a CRC, and the process is online and efficient. Please visit <https://justice.gov.bc.ca/screening/crrpa/org-access> or use the QR code below. Print or email a copy of the submission confirmation and provide it to the school office along with the other required documents. CRCs are valid for two years.

## SchoolMessenger Text Alerts (Opt-In)

1. Watch for a text from SchoolMessenger (Text #: 978338).
2. Reply with "Y" to 978338.
3. You will receive a confirmation message letting you know you're successfully subscribed.



Want alerts on more than one device? To receive text alerts on multiple phones, each phone number must opt in separately by replying "Y" to 978338.

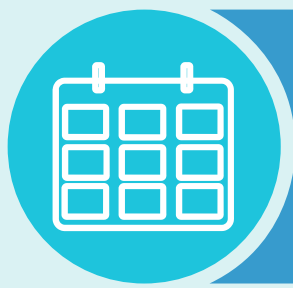
# VOLUNTEER INTERPRETERS NEEDED
