What is the PAC?

The Westwind Parent Advisory Council (PAC) is the officially recognized collective of parents & guardians at the school. **Our mission** is to promote effective communication between the school & families, and to encourage families to participate in discussion & decision-making in support of the goals set out with school faculty, staff & admin.

Who is a PAC member?

YOU! All parents & guardians of children attending Westwind are automatically members of the Westwind PAC. While the PAC does elect a PAC Executive Committee each year, **you do not need to sit on the PAC Executive to be an active PAC member.** All members are encouraged to attend meetings & participate in PAC any time!

What does the PAC do?


- The PAC meets monthly to discuss and make decisions about PAC activities & expenditures. The PAC undertakes some of the following initiatives:
- Organizing PAC activities & events to provide parent education
 - Encouraging parent involvement, communication & cooperation within the school
 - Providing feedback on school programs, policies, plans & activities
 - Fundraising to provide financial support for the goals of the school community


What is the PAC Executive Committee?


The **PAC Executive Committee** is made up of the following 4 positions:

Chairperson (Jordan) : the 'official' spokesperson of the PAC

Vice-Chairperson (Desy & Natalie): steps into the Chair as needed

Treasurer (Gigi): the money person 

Secretary/Communications (Somaiah): the minute-taker

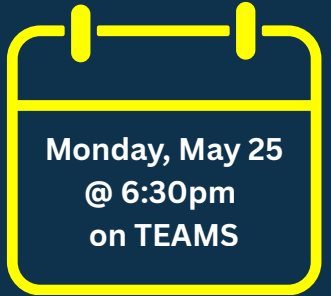

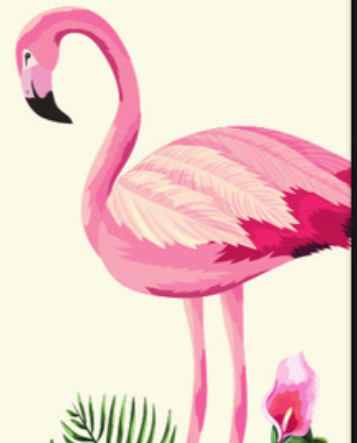
